USB Backup Utilities improve your backup capabilities. Depending on the version of FLOware software installed on your dispense system, you may now configure your system to use either the new USB Backup Utilities or the preexistent Hard Drive/USB/Floppy backup utilities.

Prerequisites for USB Backup Utilities

Hardware

USB Backup Utilities can only be installed on dispense systems operating with FLOware software and equipped with solid state disks.

Software

Any one of the following FLOware software patches must be in place on the dispense system for USB utilities to function:

- patch-2.9.3-USB
- patch-2.9.3-USBRecovery
- patch-2.9.3S or later

Configuration Option

The following option must be configured to enable/disable the USB utility menu items:

[GENERAL]

USBUtilsInstalled = True

- When USBUtilsInstalled is absent or False, USB utilities are disabled.
- When USBUtilsInstalled is present and True, USB utilities are enabled.
